WHEREAS by section 7 of the Electricity Act, it is enacted that –

- (a) no person shall commence any undertaking for the supply of electricity without previously obtaining the Minister's approval, to be signified by proclamation in which the area of supply is defined;
- (b) the proclamation shall not be issued until the undertaking is certified by the board to be in a fit condition to commence working.

WHEREAS SPV Petite Rivière Limited of Petite Rivière, has been granted, pursuant to section 6 of the Electricity Act, a permit to act as undertaker for the supply of electricity.

WHEREAS the generation plant installed by SPV Petite Rivière Limited has been duly tested, commissioned and certified by the Central Electricity Board to be in a fit condition to commence working.

NOW THEREFORE, by virtue of Section 7 of the Electricity Act, I do hereby proclaim that the Minister of Energy and Public Utilities has approved that SPV Petite Rivière Limited Commences the Supply of Electricity to the Island of Mauritius through the Central Electricity Board Grid.
